Freediving dates to the dawn of man, when his first desire to conquer the ocean was for food and pearl gathering. Today it's a world renounced sport that is growing rapidly as AIDA assists new countries in creating new national associations. Although AIDA's birth was as recent as the year 1992, world records have been sky rocketing ever since.

The athletes will challenge in three out of the six AIDA recognized competition disciplines which are: Constant Weight with Fins (CWT) contending at the Sharm Club Village on the 3rd and 4rd of September, Static (STA), and Dynamic with Fins (DYN) taking the venue to the Sharm Sporting Club on the 7th for the STA, 10th and 11th of September for the

CWT is a depth discipline where the diver descends into the deep on a single breath, and resurfaces after he attains a tag from the bottom plate, which is lured by a rope to the announced depth that the diver decides on before attempting the dive. STA is a pool discipline where the athlete immerge the respiratory tracts into the water and remains motionless to conserve as much energy as possible to attain the maximum time without

Apnea Academy was founded in 1995 by the Italian freediving legend, Umberto Pelizzari who broke 17 world records in all AIDA's eight disciplines from the period of 1990 to 2000. He decided to retire from the competition scene when he was at his climax and to dedicate his time to globalizing the sport and introducing a new approach of performing apnea; an interpretation founded more on relaxation and respiration rather than on the forcing of apnea, but also includes physical preparation. Pelizzari now conducts instructor and stage courses twice a year; the last was in May 2008 at the Sharm Club Village.
